sit, but we have been told that it will involve some of our pupils being rehoused in temporary buildings somewhere on the site.....so we're preparing for lots of change, but lots of exciting times.

A Bronze Award for School

As a school we have been recognised by the Local Authority and their 'Modeshift Stars' national scheme, as a school that does really positive work to promote children's safe travel to and from school. Modeshift Stars supports schools to develop activities in school to add to a travel plan. For many years we have promoted road safety and bicycle education with our pupils throughout our curriculum, and by applying for, and successfully attaining our bronze level accreditation, we have now been able to bid for further funding for bicycle and scooter parking resources on site. 
