

Attendance and Holidays

As a school we are constantly monitoring the attendance of each pupil and are delighted to announce that the overall attendance last year was a fantastic 97.05%, many congratulations to all our pupils. We are trying to ensure that all pupils achieve 95% attendance and if your child's attendance falls below this level, without medical reason, you will receive a letter informing you of their level of attendance and asking you to try to rectify the situation.

Similarly if your child is constantly late for school you will also receive a letter. Between the ages of 5 and 14 only 14.91% of a child's time is spent in school, so it is very important that their attendance is excellent. A reminder that the Government now dictates that Head Teachers may not grant any leave of absence for holidays during term time unless there are highly exceptional circumstances.

- The Junior children will have outdoor PE, even if it is cold, so the pupils require a tracksuit.
- If your child is in Year 3 or above they can bring a small quantity of money to purchase tuck at morning break. Please ensure that this money is kept in a small purse.
- Please make sure that your child brings a coat to school to keep them warm and dry.
- Nail varnish is NOT allowed.
- For the safety of all concerned PLEASE keep your children away from the play equipment in the infant and junior playgrounds both before and after school.
- Please keep to the paths around school and refrain from walking on the grass, across the car park or down the driveway.
- Please take care when parking do not park across our local residents' drives or ON their drives!!
- As mentioned in the newsletters numerous times, please DO NOT park on the zigzag lines, on corners, or on the pavement.
- Please remember that if your child is absent from school you must phone school to inform us of the situation by 9.30am (0121 675 2685/4040).
- Please ensure that all long hair is tied back.
- A quick reminder that no dogs, except guide dogs, are allowed on site.
- If your child rides their scooter or bike to/from school please ensure they do not ride it whilst on our school site. This is to ensure the safety of everyone.

"Public WIFI is not as safe as you may think.
