Reception Intake September 2020

The Local Authority will be writing to parents/carers of children this month who are on roll at a community or private nursery advising them how to apply for a Reception place online and where to obtain the primary information booklet. Copies of the booklet will be available online at all Birmingham Primary Schools, Libraries, Children's Centres and private and community nurseries. School admissions in Birmingham are now all completed online. The closing date for submitting application forms is 15th January 2020. Proof of address will be required to be sent to the Schools Admissions and Pupil Placements Service. Emails advising you of your child's place will be sent out by the Local Authority on 16th April 2020. Acceptance should be made by 30th April 2020 or you may lose your place. Remember that families do not need to have the internet at home. Parents can apply online from any computer with internet access, including at any library. If a family does not have access to a computer, please come into school and we will help you.

18 October 2019 - Grammar school test results sent to the parents. Parents are strongly advised to await grammar school test results before finalising applications.


31 October 2019 - Deadline for submitting application forms for Secondary schools.

"Two Factor Authentication (2FA) is a free security feature that prevents hackers from accessing your accounts, even if they know your password. Most of the big service providers now offer 2FA. 2FA means you cannot login to an account on a new device without entering a onetime code usually sent via email or by text. This means hackers need your password and access to your emails or text messages to access your account.
