Dear Parents and Governors



Merry Christmas !

As I write the last newsletter of 2020 I would like to thank all the pupils, parents, Governors and staff for their continuing hard work and support and wish you all a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. A reminder that school closes next Friday, 18th December, and that Monday 4th January is a Staff Training day. We will therefore look forward to welcoming pupils back to school on Tuesday 5th January 2021.

We obviously can't celebrate Christmas in the same way that we normally do by inviting parents either into school or to join us at All Saints Church this year, but next week you will get the chance to enjoy the children's Christmas celebrations by watching our festive film on the school website... keep an eye on our School Jotter app for an announcement early next week. We hope it really puts you in the Christmas mood and gets you looking forward to your festive break!



Friday 18th December

Some of you may have seen in the press this week that the DFE have given schools permission to move around one of their published staff training days and take it on Friday 18th December. Head Teachers and Deputy Head Teachers have been told that they need to be available for contact with the Track and Trace authorities for 6 days after the last day of term and this move is designed to not allow this to interfere with Christmas breaks. However, we have already organized our staff training for January 4th and so will not be moving any training days. This means that the children's last day in school will still be Friday 18th December 2020 and the children's first day back will still be Tuesday 5th January 2021.

Covid Symptoms and Possible Testing

Just a reminder to all families that if any pupils suffer from any COVID symptoms they are still encouraged to get a COVID test over the Christmas break. We would ask all families to let us know at school if any child has a test, and whether they prove negative or positive, up until the end of Monday 21st December by sending an email to enquiry@fouroaksprimary.bham.sch.uk. This is because this news could affect other pupils and their families who may end up having to isolate over Christmas.

Similarly, if the same thing happens in the run up to the return to school in January we would ask that families follow the same system to keep in touch. Many thanks.

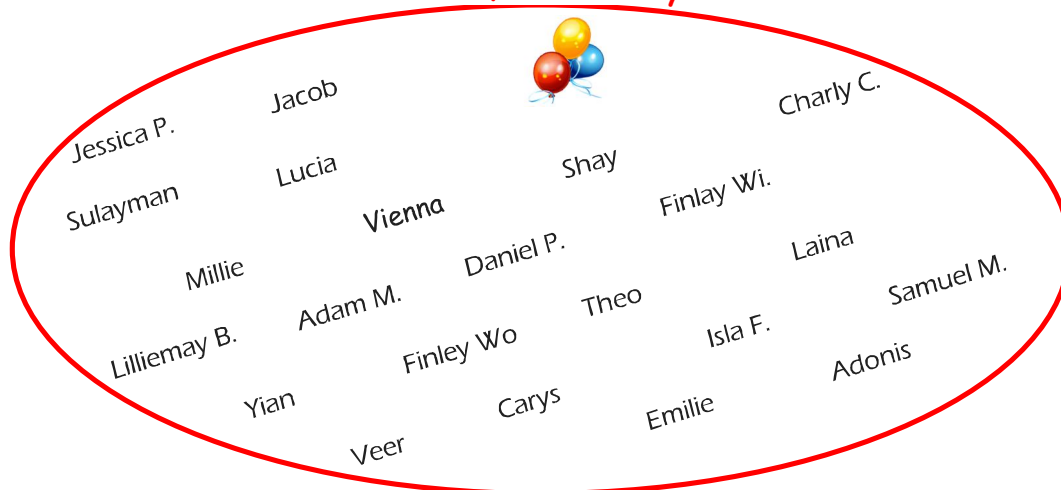

I think we may have started a new tradition for Four Oaks Primary!



School Dinners & SchoolMoney

As we have now used SchoolMoney for all payments in school for just over a year, I hope that you will agree this system is a lot easier and more convenient for everyone and is working well.

However, some parents are still not putting money into their accounts in advance, which is the only way the system can work successfully without running up individual debts.

Reminders are then sent out for each week owed and so some parents are receiving a succession of texts which are not being acted upon. Therefore, from January onwards we will now be running a system where any debts will not be allowed to go over £20. If this limit is reached, then your child will have to come to school with a packed lunch until the debt is cleared.

I hope that you all appreciate the situation that we find ourselves in and agree that this is a positive move as it is not sustainable for school to keep subsidising these cumulative debts. If you do get text reminders about your account levels, then we would really appreciate it if you could act upon them in a timely manner. However, if there are problems with settling any accounts then please contact myself or Mrs Johnson and we will see what we can do to help.

Ventilation and Warm Clothing



As part of our Local Authority risk assessment we have to make sure that all of our communal spaces, including each classroom, are well ventilated and have the windows and doors open to the flow of fresh air. Obviously as we head into December, January and February this means that children and staff will begin to feel the chilly winter air a little more. Can I ask that all parents make sure that their children are appropriately



dressed, with layers of clothing including long trousers, vests and jumpers if they are apt to feel the cold. Many thanks for your support!



Parking and Safe Driving



A plea yet again to all parents who drive to and from school. If I could ask you to be very mindful that there are many pedestrians around the school at both drop off and pick up time, and we want this time of the school day to be a safe one. We have had reports of dangerous parking, dropping off on the zig zags, and young children not being secured in child car seats, so can I ask all parents to take great care.

Attendance

This term 'attendance' at school has taken on a whole new context with whole year groups of children self-isolating for weeks at a time, and other individual pupils missing in order to protect family members. We have decided not to give out individual attendance certificates this term as we feel it would not be fair to all children. We have actively told parents that if their children have any illness symptoms at all to keep them off school for obvious reasons, so we do not want to penalize anyone for following the new rules. Instead I want to say a huge CONGRATULATIONS to everyone because if we took out our absences that are COVID related, then our school attendance would actually be 98.4% which is our highest attendance ever.....so WELL DONE EVERYONE !

Donations of Small World Figures



After Christmas we will be on the look-out for any donations of what we call Small World play figures to add to our lunchtime play equipment. By that we mean small model animals, small model vehicles or small action figures. If you have anything like this that needs a good home, then we would be happy to assist.
